Andrew (Andy) Moser, 79, Hiawatha, died suddenly Tuesday afternoon, April 30, 1974, while at a doctor's office in Hiawatha. He was not feeling well Tuesday morning and had gone to consult with the doctor about his condition. Mr. Moser was born August 13, 1894, in Nemaha County, Kansas, near Oneida, where he had made his home until 1944, when he came to Hiawatha. He was a member of the First Christian Church of Hiawatha, the IOOF Lodge #83 of Hiawatha, and Masonic Lodge #35 AF & AM of Hiawatha. he was married to Mabel Sadler on June 30, 1926. She died in May of 1964. He is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Victor (Patricia) Hogg of Williamston, Mich., Mrs. Paul (Rosalyn) Chilton of Topeka, and Mrs. Sam (Lois) Bowen of Hiawatha; one sister, Mrs. Minnie Miller of Mason City, Iowa; and 11 grandchildren. Funeral services will be held from the First Christian Church of Hiawatha at 10:30 o'clock Saturday morning, May 4, with the Rev. Clyde Mosher officiating. Patricia married Victor Hogg. They had 3 sons Andrew, Christopher, Timothy and a daughter Frances. Victor was involved with the preservation of Mackinac Island, Michigan. He also was involved in Museum work when they lived at Lawrence, Kansas. Vic died in 1988 of brain cancer. Patty and her children still live in the Lansing, Michigan area. Joanne died in January of 1949 from an allergic reaction to cold tablets. Rosalyn married Paul Chilton. They live in Topeka. Rosalyn is better known as Rosie. She had 2 sons, Kirby and John and a daughter Catherine. Lois married Sam Bowen. They live at Hiawatha farming and milking cows. They had 3 daughters, Janet, Barbara, Carolyn and a son Robert.
