Clara Moser was the fifth child born to Jacob and Anna Moser. She was born on June 7, 1888 near Oneida, Kansas. In 1900 Clara is listed in the census as a servant in the John Bromer home in Berwick, Kansas. She would have been about 12 years old. She married Ernest Gerber in January of 1907. Ernest was born in September of 1879 in Langnau, Canton Bern, Switzerland. He immigrated to the United States at the age of 18. They lived 2 miles west and 1 mile north of Oneida until 1940. They lived about a half a mile south of Grandpa Jacob and Grandma Anna Moser. Since Clara and Ernest had no girls there niece Ella Leuthold helped Clara with housework according to the 1930 Census. In 1940 they moved to Seneca where they lived on the south edge of town until 1950 when they moved into Oneida. Ernest and Clara had six sons. Edward married Frieda Knobloch in August of 1935. They had two daughters and one son. They farmed many years in the Hills, Minnesota area. Later they ran a laundromat in LeMars, Iowa before retiring to Rock Rapids where he died in 1979. Theodore married Emma Feucht in November of 1932. They had six sons and 1 daughter. Emma and Ted farmed near Lester, Iowa until retirement when they moved into Lester. Andy married Mabel Grimm. They had two daughters. Andy was killed in a logging accident in 1939 near Three Sisters, Oregon. Gilbert married Virginia Hollister in February 1938. They had two daughters and one son. Gilbert died suddenly in 1992 at their home in Sabetha. Clarence married Dolores Schmucker in July of 1945. They had two sons and a daughter. Paul married Marie Orth in Grass Valley, California. They adopted three daughters. Paul was living with one of his daughters in Idaho at the time of his death. Clara and Ernest were living at the Apostolic Christian Nursing Home in Sabetha at the time of their deaths. They are both buried at the Apostolic Christian Church Cemetery near Bern, Kansas.

Clara Moser Gerber was born near Oneida on June 7, 1888, and died at the Apostolic Christian Home in Sabetha on Oct. 2, 1965, making her span of life 77 years, three months, and 25 days. On Jan. 3, 1907 she was married to Ernest Gerber. Ernest immigrated to America in 1903.

To this union were born six sons: Edward of LeMars, Iowa; Theodore of Lester, Iowa; Paul of Grass Valley, Calif.; Gilbert and Clarence of Oneida; and Andrew who preceded her in death. She leaves to mourn her departure her husband; her five remaining sons; 21 grandchildren and 19 great grandchildren; one brother, Andrew of Hiawatha; and two sisters, Emma of Lester, Iowa and Minnie of Mason City, Iowa.

Clara has lived all her life in Nemaha County, Kansas. The last four and one-half years she was a resident of the Apostolic Christian Home of Sabetha.

Funeral services were held on Monday afternoon, Oct. 4, at the Apostolic Christian Church near Bern with burial at the church cemetery. Officiating clergymen were Lester Hartter and Harvey Grimm. Arrangements were made by the Popkess Funeral Home, Sabetha. The casket bearers were grandsons: Robert, John, Ernest, James, Leland and Max Gerber.
